Csc466 Assignment: Paper/Report

You are required to write a paper/report on your project that is consistent with the following three sets of constraints.

Section Constraints

It is required that you include the following sections in your paper. You may have a small number of additional sections as well, if you feel the need.

1. Introduction

- Present your "problem" in clear simple terms.
- Structurally foreshadow the rest of your paper.

2. Background

- Contextualize your research with respect to other work.
- Do your best to include references to several other research projects.

3. Program Description

• Describe your program at a proper level of abstraction (no Lisp; no demos).

4. Demos

- Limited, high impact output from your program, wrapped in annotations, that relate to the "Program Description" section.
- Your demos should illustrate, with the help of a narrative construction, how you performed some sort of investigation or experimentation with your program, perhaps merely to gain insights into how better to construct your program.

5. Reflections and Conclusions

Say something meaningful about:

- Your idea.
- Your plan.
- Your realization of the plan.
- Your accomplishments.
- What you think of what you accomplished.

Part Constraints

In addition to the required sections, it is required that you include four other parts in your paper/report, so that the structure of your paper/report will look like this:

1. A Title

- Four to ten words, maybe incorporating a subtitle.
- Do your best to make it meaningful.
- 2. Author Identification
 - Name.
 - Maybe something by way of "affiliation."
- 3. Abstract
 - 100 words, more or less, describing your work in abstract terms.
- 4. The Sections
- 5. The Bibliography
 - At least 8 entries. Only place works that you have cited in the paper in this bibliography.

Additional Constraints

- 1. Post a pdf document of your paper on your site by the time of the end of the first day of final exam week.
- 2. 4-8 pages.
