## Csc466 Assignment: Annotated Bibliography

Please create a document to present an annotated bibliography for your project. This annotated bibliography is intended to contain resources that you find useful in learning about phenomena relating to your research project, regardless of whether or not they will ulitimately find their way into the bibliography for your paper.

This bibliography for your project should grow in a monotonically increasing fashion. There is no reason to delete entries from this bibliography. If it turns out that you don't like something about an entry, just add that fact to your annotation. The bibliography will, in the end, be an artifact that reflects your journey through the wilderness of resources.

Please establish your project bibliography just as soon as possible, with the intention of adding more annotated entries to it as the semester unfolds, and reference it from the research portion of your web work site.

Unlike this bibliography, your research paper bibliography must ultimately consist only of resources that you directly cite in your paper. With respect to the relation ship between this annotated research bibliography and the bibliography for your paper, it seems reasonable to adopt the constraint that the unannotated entries in your eventual paper bibliography will be a subset of the annotated bibliography entries.

Please be mindful of the fact that the better (more elaborate, more relevant, more sound) your project bibliography, the more credence your research will tend to be given by those who are inclined to evaluate your research.

That said, since this is just a semester project, please aim for 10-15 sources in your annotated bibliography.

Finally, whenever possible, please link directly to the sources reference in your annotated research bibliography.
